It is concerned with the preparation, recording, extraction, presentation and analysis of financial information for the purpose of making economic decisions.

Students will also study Management Accounting where they will learn how to analyse business costs and prepare budgets. Accounting has become an important part of daily life because of the ever-increasing involvement of people in various roles in the running of clubs, societies and businesses of all types.

Students who enjoyed the bookkeeping part of Junior Cert Business should consider Accounting. The Accounting course is numerically based but theory and procedures are also covered. The course offers a hard-working student a real possibility of high grades.
